WHEREAS, 89 percent of consumers in the United States agree that small businesses contribute positively to the local community by supplying jobs and generating tax revenue; and

WHEREAS, 93 percent of consumers in the United States agree that small businesses are critical to the overall economic health of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lovelock, supports our local businesses that create jobs, boost our local economy and preserve our neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, Advocacy groups as well as public and private organizations across the country have endorsed the Saturday after Thanksgiving as Small business Saturday;
