WHEREAS, according to the United States Small Business Administration, there are currently 30.2 million small businesses in the United States, representing 99.7 percent of all businesses with employees in the United States, responsible for 65.9 percent of net new jobs created over the past 18 years; and

WHEREAS, small businesses employ 47.5 percent of the employees in the private sector in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Maria celebrates its local small businesses and the contributions they make to the local economy and community; and

WHEREAS, there are over 2,000 local small businesses in Santa Maria; and

WHEREAS, statistics show that for every \$100 spent at a local retailer, \$67 will return to the community through taxes and payroll; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Maria Valley Chamber of Commerce champions local business members through a variety of promotions yearlong and on Small Business Saturday, encouraging the community to keep their money in Santa Maria; and

WHEREAS, supporting local small businesses means strengthening the community, creating jobs, promoting commerce, helping non-profits, and providing revenue for City services.
