

## SAMPLE GRANT APPLICATION: XYZ WOODTURNERS

### **If awarded, how will you utilize the educational grant? \***

The grant will be used to continue our outreach efforts with both the students at ABC High School and the general public at various trade shows and forums.

### **What is the 'educational' aspect of the use? \***

Two areas will be covered with this grant. First, one of our members is a part time shop Instructor at the ABC High School and he provides training on the shop lathe which needs to be replaced. In addition, some of our members have held advanced training sessions on Saturdays for students and with this grant we will be able to continue these programs. Second, we participate in various trade shows and events throughout the year providing instruction and demos to the public promoting the art of woodturning.

### **Reasons for applying for this grant: \***

Lack of funding.

### **Please provide narrative describing reasons for your application: \***

Due to the momentum created by our outreach programs with the equipment purchased by our last grant in 2011, the club now has four women members and almost tripled in size. In order to continue with our efforts we need to replace the lathe which is housed in the ABC High Shop for student use during classes and is also used for demos. This lathe has been repaired several times and the bearings are worn out. The school does not have the funding to replace the lathe. In addition we need to purchase a set of turning tools.

### **What is your contribution to the project? \***

Labor hours.

### **Please provide narrative describing your contributions to the project: \***

Our contribution to the project is primarily instructional labor and turning materials due to limited funds. We have raised funds and purchased a small camera for showing live demos but need a TV monitor. Currently one of our members brings his home TV to the demos. With our own monitor, we can mount it to a wall in the High School shop and also use it for trade shows. We would use the balance of the grant of \$128 to give a scholarship to a worthy student going on to a trade school. We would raise and contribute the other \$78 and make the scholarship \$200 from AAW and the XYZ Woodturners.

### **How will your plan change if you do not receive a grant, or if you receive a reduced grant? \***

If not funded, the school does not have a lathe to use and ends our ongoing efforts to promote the craft of woodturning for the students. With a reduced grant, we will be limited as to providing the kind of intensive training and experience that the craft deserves.

### **If you receive a grant, how will you/your chapter/school help others to benefit from the grant? \***

Woodturning and wood working are natural crafts in the northern part of the state since our forests are our greatest natural resource and provide a source of turning materials. Our mission is to build on that source and continue to provide to the best of our ability a medium and learning skills for all ages to turn wood into something that can be appreciated.
