### **One (1) \$5000 "Tradition and Innovation Scholarship Award" is available.**

(Applicable to the 2019-20 Academic Year and payable in the Fall of 2019) Available to a full-time graduate student majoring in real estate or a full-time undergraduate student majoring in real estate. Applicants must be enrolled at UW Madison for the Fall 2019 Semester. Previous recipients of this scholarship award are not eligible for selection again.

### **Application Process**

Scholarship application should include the following:

- A. A completed graduate scholarship application form
- B. Resume
- C. A two-page, double-spaced essay (please include your name at the top of each page)

Essay submissions should be double-spaced and should NOT exceed two pages in length using at least a 10-pt. font size. Your name should be included on each page of this application. Please include your essay response and resume in the same document that contains your application.
