Available to a full-time undergraduate student majoring in real estate. <u>Applicants must be enrolled at UW Madison for the Fall 2019 Semester.</u> Previous recipients of this scholarship award are not eligible for selection again.

Application Process

Scholarship application should include the following:

- A. A completed undergraduate scholarship application form.
- B. Resume
- C. A two-page, double-spaced essay (please include your name at the top of each page)

The essay questions are located on the last page of this document. Your essay should address ONE of the questions. Essay submissions should be double-spaced and should NOT exceed two pages in length using at least a 10-point font. Your name should be included on each page of this application. Please include your essay response and resume in the same document that contains your application. Submission Deadline

Scholarship applications must be received by **March 10**, **2019**. Applications received after this date will not be accepted for any reason.

Note: Scholarship recipients who do not complete the degree listed on the scholarship application at the University of Wisconsin-Madison must refund any scholarship payment made to them.
