Wisconsin's legislators and constitutional officers have been sworn in and the 2019-2020 legislative session is underway! WSTA is looking to build on the very successful 2017-2018 legislative session, which saw significant progress toward 911 modernization with funding for the creation of a statewide ESInet; substantial funding increases and WSTA supported policy changes to the PSC Broadband Expansion Grant Program; a sales and use tax exemption for services performed during a disaster period by telecommunications utilities; and legislation to create a Telecommuter Forward! Community certification to promote remote worker options using our broadband. In the new legislative session, WSTA priorities include working on legislation to exempt your future broadband investments from annual property tax payments and the creation of a state grant program to facilitate PSAP upgrades with digital equipment to expedite connecting to the ESInet. We need your continued participation in order to be successful!
