



Dr. Jennifer Engler is an Associate Professor of Psychology and Chair of the Department of Psychology at York College of Pennsylvania. She received her PhD in Clinical Psychology from the University of Tennessee in 2004, specializing in childhood and adolescent development. While completing a post-doctoral fellowship in the Adolescent and Sports Medicine Division of Texas Children's Hospital, she gained additional specialized training in the treatment of eating disorders.

At York College of Pennsylvania, Dr. Engler teaches undergraduate and graduate courses related to childhood development, both normal and atypical, and also teaches in the introductory research and senior capstone courses. She is actively involved in pedagogical research that informs her teaching practice and also studies adolescent identity and poverty attitude change.
