This easily accessed, web based prep course is not required for certification, though it is the best study tool available for the LPC exam. LPC Exam	The LPC designation requires a passing score on the LPC exam. This advanced credential was developed by over 300 loss prevention leaders and experts. 200 questions long. 3 hour time limit.
